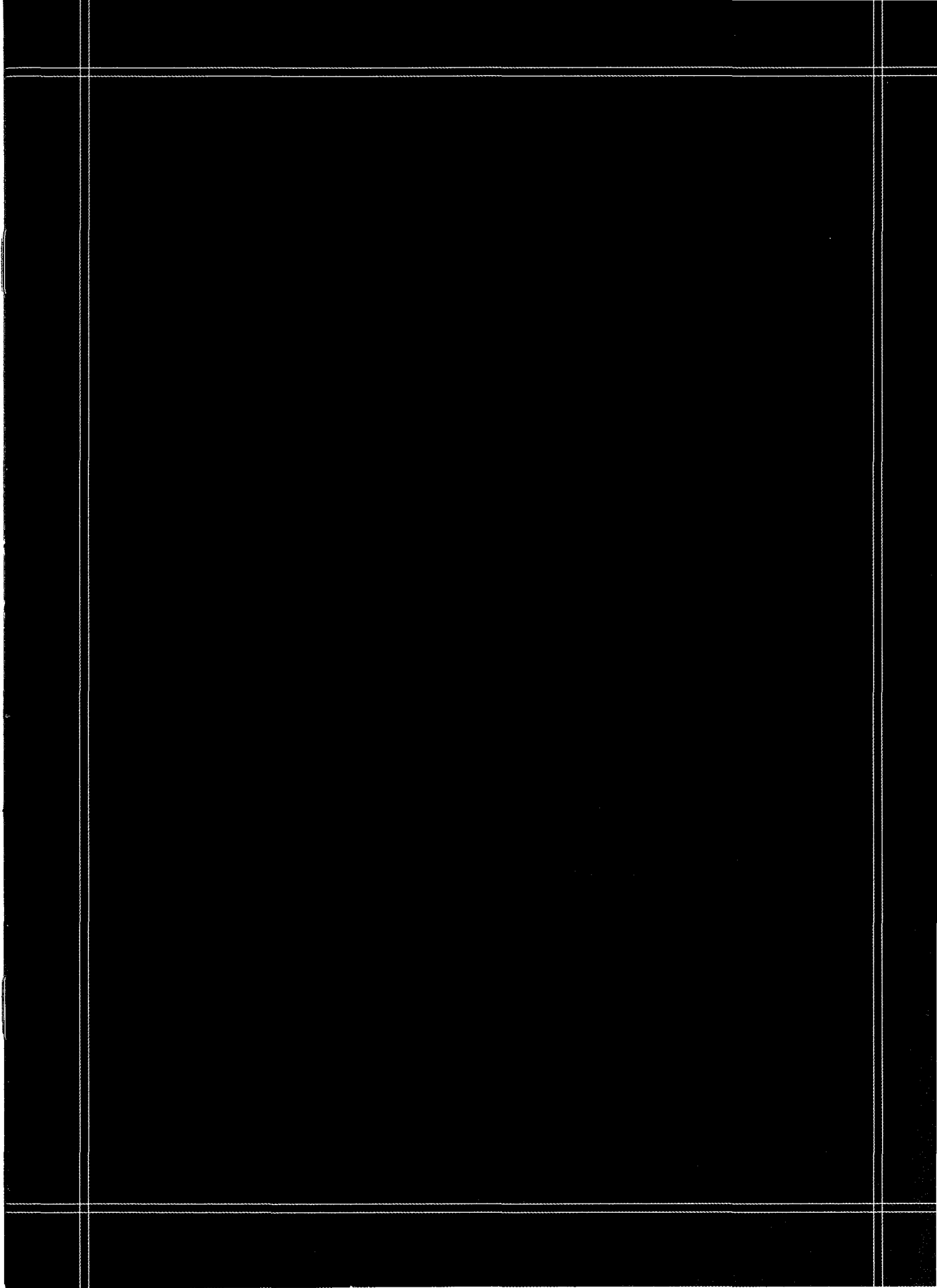

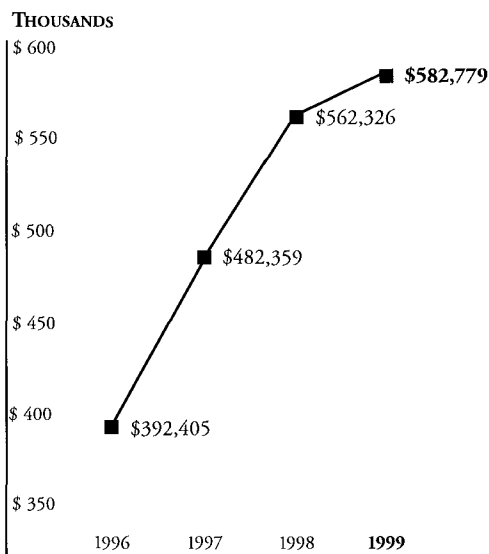
THE MILLENNIUM SOCIETY

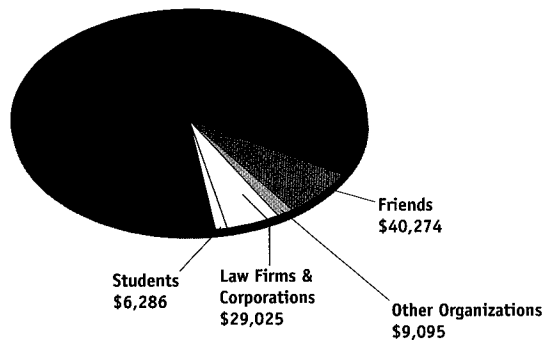

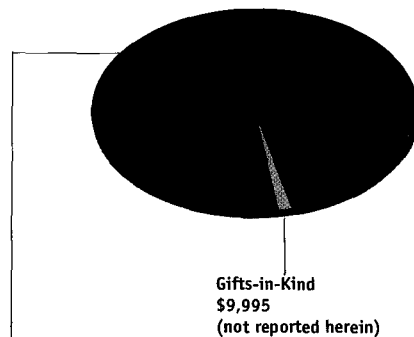

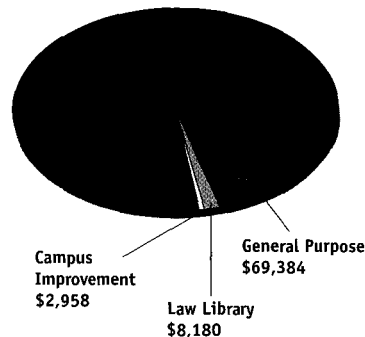
