

Governor Among 300 At Justice Carter Rites

Three hundred friends and associates, including Governor Edmund G. Brown, attended simple Masonic Presbyterian funeral rites yesterday afternoon for State Supreme Court Justice Jesse W. Carter.

The services, in the First Presbyterian Church, San Anselmo, were conducted by the Rev. Dr. Carl Gordon Howie of Calvary Presbyterian Church, San Francisco.

Justice Carter died Sunday at the age of 70 in San Rafael General Hospital.

During his 19 years on the State's highest tribunal he gained a reputation as an outspoken champion of individual rights.

In addition to his immediate family and Governor Brown, others who attended the funeral included Attorney General Stanley Mosk, Chief State Justice Phil S. Gibson, all Marin County judges, Federal and State judges from San Francisco, and a number of attorneys.

Burial was in Mt. Tamalpais Cemetery, San Rafael.
