DONATIONS ENHANCE LIBRARY COLLECTION

Thanks to a generous donation from **Professor Sompong Sucharitkul** the Law Library has been able to greatly enhance its collection of International Law materials. New additions include the four-volume set, *Jurisprudence on the Rights of the Child*, an up-to-date edition of *Encyclopedia of the United Nations and International Agreements*, materials on the law of ocean waters, human rights law and private international law, among others. We are grateful for this opportunity to increase our collection of international law titles.

Mrs. D. Jamison McDaniel has recently made another donation to the McDaniel Fund for Law and Literature, enabling us to purchase a number of essential titles for the Law and Literature collection. The McDaniel Law and Literature Fund began in 1993 to assist and enhance instruction in the subject area "law and literature" through the purchase of books and other materials, as well as for the provision of supplementary funds for expenses related to its teaching. The course has been taught by various visiting and Golden Gate University faculty over the years. In 1996, Mrs. McDaniel gave a supplementary gift to the Law School to create the McDaniel Law & Film Fund for the purchase of books, materials, and equipment for the teaching of a Law & Film course. With this new gift in 2005, the law library has purchased additional books from a list of titles essential to any Law & Literature and Law & Film collection.

Law Library hours during the December holiday period are:

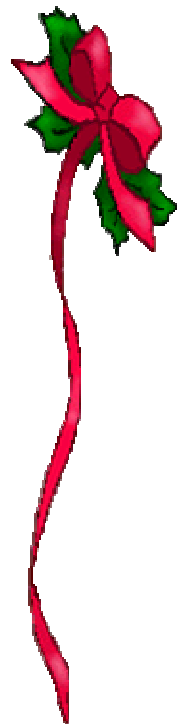
December 18—January 2: Law Library Closed.

The fastest and best general-purpose spyware checker comes with the Yahoo Toolbar (toolbar.yahoo.com). After it is installed, click on the target cross-hairs icon in your Yahoo Toolbar for Internet Explorer and select Run Anti-Spy. Check all of the checkboxes and click Begin Scan. Once it is finished, click the Remove All button; it should not take more than a couple of minutes.

Scanning for viruses will take about 45 minutes to an hour. The lab recommends that you scan with a third-party online virus scan, regardless of whether you have software installed on your computer (such as McAfee, Norton, or Trendmicro). We recommend you use Trendmicro's Housecall; it is free: housecall.trendmicro.com

Taking these steps will help protect from having software lock-ups and other problems while taking finals. It is a sound practice to do this throughout the semester, as well.
