Partner to Offer Diversity Scholarship**

San Francisco, Calif.: Golden Gate University School of Law is proud to announce that The Morrison & Foerster Foundation has selected Golden Gate Law as its Bay Area partner in awarding its annual Stephen S. Dunham Scholarship. The scholarship—named for Steve Dunham, a former firm-wide chair of Morrison & Foerster and now Vice President and General Counsel of The Johns Hopkins University—is intended for an incoming law student from a group historically underrepresented in the legal profession.

Previously, the scholarship has been awarded to students at the University of Denver Sturm College of Law and the University of Colorado School of Law. The Foundation established a similar scholarship in 2011 at the University of the District of Columbia David A. Clark School of Law in Washington, D.C.

The Morrison & Foerster Foundation's Chair, Paul T. Friedman said, "We are pleased to partner with Golden Gate University School of Law to provide meaningful financial support for promising diverse law students, while continuing to honor the firm's former Chair, Steve Dunham, in his passion for education and increasing diversity in the legal profession."

This spring, GGU Law will select and announce its first scholar for this award, called The Morrison & Foerster Foundation – Stephen S. Dunham Scholarship. The scholar will begin his or her first year of law school in fall 2012 and will be eligible to renew his or her scholarship annually over three years.

GGU Law Dean Drucilla Ramey said, "The Morrison & Foerster Foundation – Stephen S. Dunham Scholarship will make it possible for a talented, accomplished individual from an historically underrepresented group to attend law school at an institution with a long history of providing equal access to legal education – at a significantly reduced cost. We are proud to honor Stephen S. Dunham's leadership and to recognize The Morrison & Foerster Foundation's commitment to increasing diversity in the legal profession."
