Lawyers Sought to Judge Regional Trial Competition

SAN FRANCISCO— Ninety lawyers are needed to serve as judge/evaluators for the 24 teams of students from California law schools who will be competing in the regionals for the ABA's National Trial Competition scheduled for the evenings of Feb. 10 and 11 here.

Judge/evaluators are needed for the three-person teams. All team members will evaluate the competition, and one also will preside over the trial. Lawyers serving as judge/evaluators are entitled to MCLE credit for participating in the program.

Student teams will be trying the case of *Harper v. Board of Education*, in which the plaintiff has sued the board after she was beaten by a student, while visiting the school. Trials are scheduled from 5:30 to 10 p.m. both days of competition at City Hall.

The regional competition is being hosted by the Golden Gate University School of Law. Bernard L. Segal, Golden Gate law professor, is directing the program.
